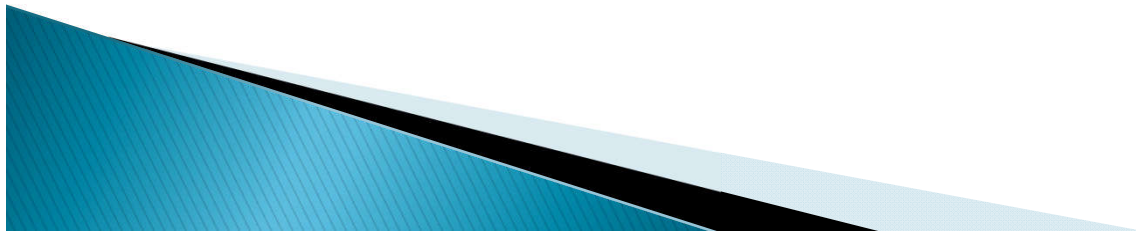


HOPE worldwide Nepal Project Report

The main objective of our organization is to empower disadvantage & poor children through free education till primary level and Adults in our society through different vocational trainings.

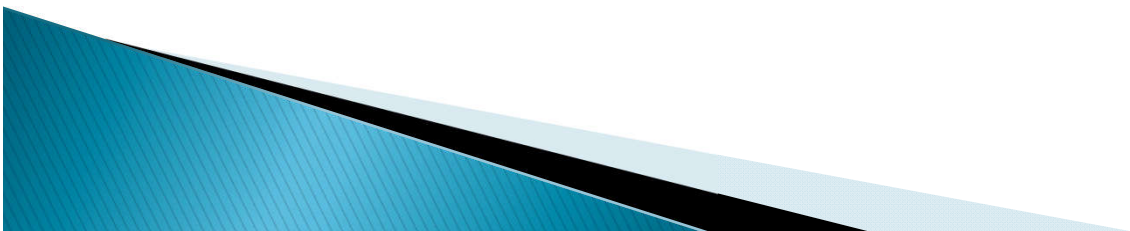

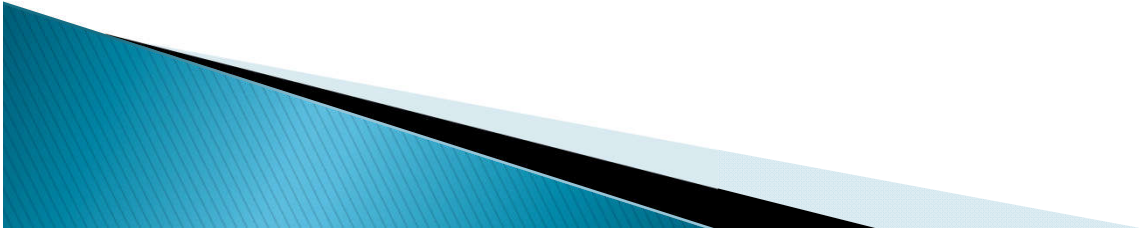
This year our children were very happy more than ever. They have enjoyed this very special day with special Cake, snacks, chocolate & gifts. They have performed a special dance & played many games.
