VTC, Certificate Distribution Program

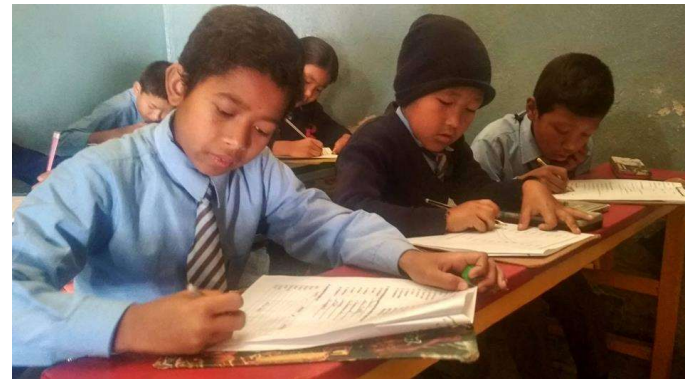

Story of Manab Pariyar



Manab Pariyar is five years old. His three family are from the remote and underdeveloped district of Humla, Tajakot. In 2018 they migrated to Kathmandu in search of better living. His Father Mahendra Pariyar is a very hard-working man, but his work as a labor did not provide him enough earnings to support his family properly. Due to hardship and financial instability his mother committed suicide. Manab enrolled to HOPE school (Asha Vidhyashram) this year.

Unable to understand and no one to guide him though, he started crying and disturbing the class while the teachers taught lessons. He was very scared to answer of anything asked. He couldn't read, write and speak simple words.

We taught him the alphabet, the days of the week, months of the year and some of the meaning of frequently used words. He has now started enjoying the classes. He is very eager, sincere, committed and hardworking and stands out among the class students.

His father is very thankful to HOPE *worldwide* Nepal.
